A cost of living increase of 2% on minimum effective salary (salary + housing) is proposed. When Pension/Major Medical and SECA Reimbursement are adjusted based on the \$60,180 minimum effective salary (salary + housing), the total is an increase of 1.91%

Allowed Personal Time Off of 28 days including 4 Sundays and Continuing Education of 14 days including 2 Sundays remains the same.
